Ms Grace Grace asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION: Will he provide an update on the property currently used by Queensland Health and owned by Education Queensland, located on St Paul's Terrace next to the Brisbane Central State School

ANSWER:

I'm pleased to inform the Member for Brisbane Central that Brisbane Central State School will have access to the property on St Paul's Terrace to use as a new school hall.

The Department of Education, Training and the Arts (DETA) is currently in negotiations with Queensland Health to relocate the Lutwyche Community Health Centre, which is operating on land owned by DETA.

Queensland Health has indicated it will work with DETA to relocate its staff and activities. This will allow for a smooth hand-over of the property back to the Brisbane Central State School.

It is hoped Queensland Health will vacate the property during the 2009 school year.
