

**Question on Notice

Asked on 11 November 2008**

MR MALONE asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR ROBERTS) -

**QUESTION:**

As the Queensland Ambulance Service has an extensive replacement program for its operational vehicles -

- (1) How many vehicles in Queensland (a) are currently 9 or more years old and (b) have logged mileage of more than 350,000 kilometres?
- (2) When will these vehicles be replaced?
- (3) How much does each new ambulance cost?

**ANSWER:**

**(1) & (2)**

I refer the Member for Mirani to my response on 13 October 2008 to his Question on Notice No. 1121 "Will he advise the number of Queensland Ambulance Service ambulances with more than 300,000 kilometres on the clock, where these ambulances are based and when these high kilometre vehicles will be replaced?"

**(3)**

The Mercedes Sprinter 318 has an on road fully equipped value of approximately \$180,000. The Toyota Troop Carrier 4 x 4 has an on road fully equipped value of approximately \$135,000.
