MR COPELAND asked the Minister for Communities, Minister for Disability Services, Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Minister for Multicultural Affairs, Seniors and Youth (**MS NELSON-CARR**)–

How many people living in the Darling Downs/South West Queensland region have applied for and been granted Adult Lifestyle Support packages (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

From 1 July 2008 to 12 November 2008, a total of 58 Adult Lifestyle Support Program applications were made by people living in the Darling Downs/South West Queensland Region.

Forty-six of these applications were new, whilst 12 were updated applications from previous applicants.

Between 1 July 2008 and 12 November 2008, there have been no funding rounds in any region around the state. Therefore, no packages have been granted during this period.
