QUESTION:

With reference to the important service provided to the hinterland of the Sunshine Coast by the Public Trustee Office in Nambour-

Will he ensure that this service is retained in the town of Nambour?

ANSWER:

There is a growing demand for the services of The Public Trustee on the Sunshine Coast including the hinterland. The Public Trustee's current lease of the Nambour office premises expires on 30 December 2009.

A review of office locations and future accommodation requirements of the Public Trustee has commenced. The review includes the Sunshine Coast as well as other centres and is being conducted in consultation with the Department of Public Works.

The Public Trustee is committed to delivering quality services to the people of the Sunshine Coast and I assure the Member that the Public Trustee will continue to provide quality services to the people of Nambour.
