

**Question on Notice

MRS CUNNINGHAM asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to police stations at Gladstone, Mt Larcom, Calliope, Many Peaks and Tannum Sands—

- (1) What is the staffing allocation for each station and for each area, for example uniform, traffic, etc (reported separately)?
- (2) What is the actual number of staff currently working in each area (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

All these police divisions are in the Gladstone Police District. As at 1 November 2008, the approved police strength for the District was 151 and the actual police strength was 153.

As at 1 November 2008, the approved and actual police strengths for the relevant divisions were as follows:

Division	Approved strength	Actual strength
Gladstone	51	53
Mt Larcom	1	1
Calliope	2	2
Many Peaks	1	1
Tannum Sands	12	12

Within the Gladstone Police District, 55 approved positions are allocated to specialist policing services such as the Criminal Investigation Branch, Child Protection and Investigation Unit, Tactical Crime Squad and Traffic Branch. Officers attached to these specialist functions perform operational duties and provide backup support to all divisions within the District.
