Mr PAT PURCELL asked the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland (Mr Shine) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the dedication to community service of the many Justices of the Peace and Commissioners for Declarations throughout Queensland and in particular, in the electorate of Bulimba –

What avenues are available for them to advise residents of their appointment and services they provide?

ANSWER:

There are 826 registered Justices of the Peace and Commissioners for Declarations in the Bulimba Electorate.

Justices of the Peace and Commissioners for Declarations can advise residents of their services and availability by:

- listing their contact details on the Department of Justice and Attorney-General website: www.justice.qld.gov.au;
- volunteering for the “JP’s in the Community” Program. In the Bulimba Electorate this service is located at Cannon Hill Kmart Plaza from 10:00am to 1:00pm on Tuesdays;
- voluntarily displaying a letter box sign and/or window stickers;
- voluntarily advertising in the yellow pages;
- voluntarily advertising in local newspapers; and
- registering their name with the electorate office and the local police station.
