MRS ATTWOOD asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE) —

QUESTION:

Further to my personal representations to her regarding the vacant land on the Wacol Prison Reserve south of Wolston Creek and as I note that the Brisbane City Council incorporates this land in the Centenary Suburbs Neighbourhood Plan—

Will she outline progress in relation to the future recreational use of this land which was formerly earmarked for the 'Westgate' development and which adjoins the Mt Ommaney Electorate?

ANSWER:

The land south of Wolston Creek which is in the Inala Electorate is part of the Wacol Correctional Precinct and provides a buffer between the prisons and residents of Riverhills and is utilised by the Department of Primary Industry in the operation of its tick fever research facility.

Other than the local Junior Rugby League Football Club, I am not aware of further plans to expand the activities on this site.
