MR RICKUSS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICKEL) —

QUESTION:

How many TransLink passenger trips are being undertaken per day from Helidon to Gatton and Gatton to Rosewood Railway Station?

ANSWER:

I am advised

- there were a total of 1,414 passenger trips from Helidon to Gatton undertaken in the month of October. This equated to an average of 61 passenger trips per day (week day only service).
- there were a total of 3,293 passenger trips from Gatton to Rosewood undertaken in October 2008 which equates to 106 passenger trips per day (seven days a week service).
