MR LEE ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICKEL) —

QUESTION:

How many new commuter car parking spaces has the government provided at railway stations within the Brisbane municipal area during the last three years?

ANSWER:

I am advised, the State Government, through the TransLink Transit Authority, has invested more than \$26 million to upgrade parking and bus interchange facilities at rail stations since 2004, delivered as part of the *TransLink Network Plan* for South East Queensland. A further \$9 million has been committed in the 2008/2009 financial year. Further expansion of parking facilities at rail stations has also occurred in conjunction with major rail projects being delivered under the *South East Queensland Infrastructure Plan and Program - Rail Upgrade*.

Since November 2005, a total of 721 additional car parking spaces have been provided at the following rail stations within the Brisbane Local Government Area under the TransLink rail program and the *South East Queensland Infrastructure Plan and Program*, including:
