MR STEVENS asked the Minister for Public Works, Housing and Information and Communication Technology  
(MR SCHWARTEN)-

**QUESTION:**

- (1) How many vehicles are not being deployed at the present time?
- (2) How much money has been lost by the government car fleet through the write-down of used car values for the last 18 months?

**ANSWER:**

- (1) QFleet is responsible for the procurement, leasing, fleet management and remarketing of approximately 14,000 motor vehicles. QFleet manages and maintains its stock levels by disposing of vehicles at the end of their service life through public auction. As at 30 November 2008, 787 vehicles were being prepared for, or were awaiting sale. This represents 5.7% of the fleet and is well within the established benchmark.
- (2) Over the last 18 months, there has been no write-down of used car values.
