MR STEVENS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICKEL)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the current level of security on trains and at train stations across the State and the many complaints to my office regarding the lack of adequate security on trains and especially at train stations—

- (1) What measures will he implement in the near future to make sure incidents like the recent one at the Nerang station do not occur again?
- (2) What form of additional security services will he deliver to ensure the safety of train travelling Queenslanders beyond the festive season (in particular at the Robina and Nerang train stations)?
