DR FLEGG ASKED THE TREASURER (MR FRASER)—

1. Will he detail the number of ministerial staff employed by his department (and in his office) for the last three most recent years available, detailed separately?
2. Will he also detail how many of these staff there are in the following pay bands (a) 0-\$50,000, (b) \$50,001-\$80,000, (c) \$80,001-\$100,000, (d) \$100,001-\$150,000, (e) \$150,001-\$200,000, (f) \$200,001-\$300,000, and (g) \$300,001+ for these same three years, detailed separately?

ANSWER:
