

**Question on Notice

Asked on Wednesday 12 March 2008**

MR DICKSON asked the Minister for Police and Corrective Services (MS SPENCE)-

QUESTION:

- 1) How many offenders currently on dangerous prisoner (sexual offender) orders are wearing electronic monitoring devices?
- 2) How many breaches of the curfews have been recorded by the department since the most recent amendments came in?
- 3) How many breaches have been taken back to the Supreme Court since the most recent amendments came in?
- 4) How many resulted in a charge under the new 'breach of order' provision?

ANSWER:

- 1) Currently, there are nine offenders wearing electronic monitoring devices.
- 2) Since the commencement of the amendments in August 2007, there have been five breaches of curfew recorded by the Agency.
- 3) Since August 2007, 39 breaches have been returned to the Supreme Court. These breaches relate to eight offenders.
- 4) Four offenders have been charged under this section of the (Act) for breaching their supervision order.
