

Question on Notice

Asked on Wednesday, 12 March 2008

Mr McARDLE asked the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland (Mr Shine) -

QUESTION:

- (1) How many young offenders have been referred to the Murri Youth Court for 2006-07 and 2007-08 to date (reported per court)?
- (2) How many young offenders have failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court for 2006-07 and 2007-08 to date (reported per court)?
- (3) How many young offenders were subsequently sentenced to terms of imprisonment through the Murri Youth Court for 2006-07 and 2007-08 to date (reported per court)?

ANSWER:

- (1) 26 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Brisbane in 2006-07 and 38 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Brisbane in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

Nine offenders referred were to Murri Youth Court at Caboolture in 2006-07 and 45 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Caboolture in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

Four offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cherbourg in 2006-07 and 15 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cherbourg in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

No offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Caloundra in 2006-07 and 10 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Caloundra in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

No offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cleveland in 2006-07 and 15 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cleveland in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

No offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cairns in 2006-07 and eight offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Cairns in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

31 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Rockhampton in 2006-07 and 113 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Rockhampton in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

19 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Townsville in 2006-07 and 62 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Townsville in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

47 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Mt Isa in 2006-07 and 45 offenders were referred to Murri Youth Court at Mt Isa in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

- (2) No offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Brisbane in 2006-07 and six offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Brisbane in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

Four offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Caboolture in 2006-07 and five offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Caboolture in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

No offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Cherbourg in 2006-07 and no offenders failed to appear at the Murri Youth Court at Cherbourg in 2007-08 to 19 March 2008.

Note 1: The numbers of those sentenced to detention include those released immediately as a consequence of an immediate parole release date. Fully suspended sentences are not counted as a detention event.
