**Asked on 13 March 2008**

Mr Rickuss asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION:

MR RICKUSS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (MR WELFORD)—

Will he advise the Day 8 numbers for teachers and pupils for the last three years for all schools in the Lockyer Electorate (these schools are in the Logan Metro South Moreton (Ipswich) and Toowoomba Education districts.)?

ANSWER:

Staffing levels in state primary and secondary schools are determined on the basis of the Day 8 enrolment collection, which fell this year on 7 February 2008.

Details of Day 8 enrolments and the allocation of teachers, teacher aides and support staff for 2006, 2007 and 2008 for schools in the Lockyer Electorate are provided in Attachment 1.

- Staffing allocations data above do not include additional resources that may be provided from regional allocations to support students with learning needs and students with disabilities.
- FTE = Full-time Equivalent
- Total Number of Teachers includes classroom teachers, school support teachers and classified teaching positions, for example, Principal, Deputy Principal, Head of Department and Head of Curriculum.

4. Total Teacher Aide Time is quoted in hours per week consistent with the manner in which the allocation is provided to schools. It should be noted that for the purpose of comparing teacher aide allocations from 2006 to 2008, teacher aide hours for 2006 include pre-school hours while the 2007 teacher aide allocations include hours to support the **half** cohort of prep enrolments and the 2008 teacher aide allocations include hours to support the **full** cohort of prep enrolments.
5. Total Support Staff may include the allocation of Business Service Managers (formerly known as Registrars), Administrative Officers, Administrative Officers (AAEP), Scientific Operations Officers, School Officers (Facilities and Grounds) and Agricultural Assistants (excludes Teacher Aides).
6. Support Staff allocations (excluding Agricultural Assistants) are based on February Effective or July Census enrolments.
7. Data excludes Special School enrolments and allocations where applicable.
