MR DICKSON asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)—

QUESTION:

- (1) Will she advise when the new Mooloolaba office for the Sunshine Coast Water Police, promised in the last State budget, will be operational?
- (2) Given that this relocation will allow the Water Police direct access to their police vessel, rather than having to drive from Kawana Station to Mooloolaba, will the Minister confirm that the new station will be delivered in this financial year?

ANSWER:

(1) & (2)

The provision of a new facility for the Kawana Water Police is part of this Government's commitments from the 2006 State election. The Queensland Police Service is managing this project, along with 39 other major capital works projects, over a three-year rolling plan. These projects will deliver new, replacement and upgraded facilities across the State. Work on the new facility for the Kawana Water Police has commenced and is scheduled for completion in mid-2009.
