**MR COPELAND ASKED THE TREASURER (MR FRASER)—**

With reference to the electorate of Cunningham—

Will he outline the (a) revenue taken from poker machines in the electorate over the past three years (reported separately) and (b) funding approved via the Gambling Community Benefit Fund for the electorate over the past three years (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

(a) Details of gaming machine revenue are not collected on the basis of electorates.

Gaming machine statistics are publicly available at <http://www.qogr.qld.gov.au/statistics/> and are displayed by the geographical areas determined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics - Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) 2001. The 'Metered Win' for Clubs and Hotels (reported separately) is available for each Statistical Division from April 2006 onward.
