Asked on 29 April 2008**

Mr Johnson asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)—

QUESTION:

Will she provide crime statistics, listed by type of crime and separated by year, for the South Bank precinct for 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08 to date?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service and Bligh Government provide comprehensive annual statistical information for all police districts and regions. This data provides an accurate and statistically relevant indication of crime in Queensland and is published in the Service's Annual Statistical Review.

There are a number of privacy and confidentiality issues surrounding the general release of statistical information for Police Divisions and specific locations such as the Southbank precinct. This is due, in some instances, to the relatively small statistical sample which the Police Division or the specific location may provide and the consequential ability or likelihood of the provided information being able to directly or indirectly identify individuals.

Queensland Government Information Standard 42 precludes the provision of information that may identify individuals both directly and indirectly. Information provided for divisions, precincts and specific locations can potentially contravene this standard.
