MR NICHOLLS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICKEL) —

QUESTION:

Will he table Queensland Transport's contract with Cubic Transportation Systems, the contractor behind the troublesome public transport *go* card?

ANSWER:

The contract between the Queensland Government and Cubic Transportation Systems is bound by standard non-disclosure clauses which prevents the Queensland Government from unilaterally disclosing details of the contract.

To do otherwise would place the government in breach of contract with its contractor.

I am happy to provide the Honourable Member a briefing on the terms of the contract at his convenience.
