MRS SCOTT asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)—

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the proposed Marsden Police Station on Browns Plains Road—

- (1) What stage has current planning reached?
- (2) When will work commence on the building?

**ANSWER:**

This Government has committed \$260 million to boost law and order, including the creation of six new police divisions and the construction of more than 20 new police stations and facilities around the State over the next three years.

As part of this commitment, the new Creatmead-Marsden Police Station will be constructed at 501 Browns Plains Road. The station is currently being planned and is in the Contract Documentation Stage. Tenders are expected to be called in July 2008.

It is anticipated that construction of the Creatmead-Marsden Police Station will commence in August 2008 with completion expected in June 2009. The estimated total cost of the project is \$5.4 million.

Until completion of the new station the policing needs of residents in these suburbs will continue to be met by officers from the Browns Plains Police Division. Local policing services are also being delivered from the Neighbourhood Police Beat at 6 Whiteman Street, Crestmead.
