MRS MENKENS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITY SERVICES AND HOUSING AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (MS STRUTHERS)—

What is the total cost of preparation, printing and distribution of the recent Positively Ageless booklets, how many were printed and to how many people were they distributed?

ANSWER:

The Department of Communities is currently leading the development of a whole-of-government Seniors' Strategy and Action Plan, focusing on key deliverables to support vulnerable or disadvantaged older people.

This strategy is being developed in response to views expressed by representatives of peak seniors organisations, and will help to guide planning for services to Queensland seniors into the future.

The *Positively Ageless—Developing a Queensland seniors' strategy* discussion and response papers were launched on 16 September 2009 to inform the development of this strategy.

Positively Ageless booklets, printed at a cost of \$11,044, are being distributed at consultation forums and to over 80 non-government and seniors organisations
