Mr SPRINGBORG asked the Attorney-General and Minister for Industrial Relations (Mr Dick) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the Juvenile Justice Amendment Act, for each of the last two financial years, and for the year to date (each year reported separately)—

How many juveniles sentenced for each of the following offences (a) drug trafficking, (b) production of dangerous drugs, (c) supply of dangerous drugs, (d) rape, (e) attempted rape, (f) armed robbery, (g) unarmed robbery and (h) serious assault, have been publicly named by the Courts or the Director-General (each offence reported separately)?

ANSWER:

The Minister responsible for the *Juvenile Justice Act 1992* is the Minister for Community Services and Housing and Minister for Women. That is the Minister to whom this question should properly be directed.
