**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister outline the internal structure of the Queensland Studies Authority, including a breakdown of staffing roles, numbers of staff for each outcome and the costs of staffing each outcome in 2008–09 and 2009–10 (to date)?

**ANSWER:**

The Queensland Studies Authority is an independent statutory body.

I have been advised by the Queensland Studies Authority (QSA) that it currently has a total of 237.8 full-time equivalent staff, excluding casual staff. These staff are organised within three divisions and an Office of the Director.
