# QUESTION:

In the event of riparian land being acquired for the proposed Traveston Crossing Dam and associated offsets, will the government assure affected farmers that they will still have access to water?

## ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Gympie his question.

On 11 November 2009 the Federal Minister for Environment, Heritage and the Arts announced his draft decision not to approve the Traveston Crossing Dam Project.

In relation to properties currently owned by Queensland Water Infrastructure (QWI), QWI has, and will continue to, liaise with individual tenants with respect to their specific circumstances and, where appropriate, provide access to water.
