MR WELLINGTON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR MAIN ROADS (MR WALLACE)—

QUESTION:

When will the Nambour to Mapleton road be upgraded?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Nicklin for the question.

I am pleased to advise that the \$6.5 million project to upgrade the Nambour-Mapleton Road between Willandra Place and Mapleton is expected to start construction in mid-2010.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is almost finished planning for the project and the design phase will take approximately eight months.

The planning has primarily focused on strengthening and resurfacing the pavement on this section of the road and improving driver visibility at the intersection of Sherwell Road.

The proposed works will improve safety for motorists with installation of guardrail, visibility clearing and improvements to property access where required.
