MR KNUTH asked the Deputy Premier and Minister for Health (MR LUCAS)-

QUESTION:

With reference to Eventide—

- (1) How many residents have working TVs in their private rooms?
- (2) How long will it take to repair TVs reported as faulty?
- (3) Will TVs no longer able to be repaired be replaced?

ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Dalrymple for his question.

I am advised that TVs located in some patients rooms are not owned, operated or maintained by Queensland Health. They are provided for individual patients by their families, or they are owned by the patients themselves.

Queensland Health does provide TVs in common areas. If the TVs owned by Queensland Health require maintenance, this should be brought to the attention of Eventide management.
