MR CRANDON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR CHILD SAFETY AND MINISTER FOR SPORT (MR REEVES)—

Will the Minister advise of the nature, length and broadcasters of the actual television broadcast coverage of the SuperGP in the North American market and the local time of such broadcasts?

ANSWER:

The owner of the broadcast arrangements for the 2009 Nikon SuperGP is V8 Supercars Australia.

V8 Supercars Australia advises that its broadcast, including the Super GP on the Gold Coast, was fed into around 110 countries worldwide. The broadcasting of the event to local markets is up to the individual television stations.

The nature, length and broadcast of the event in the North American Market is not information held by the Queensland Government, however, I am assured by V8 Supercars Australia that broadcast of the event was received by North American media providers.
