DR DOUGLAS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR CHILD SAFETY AND MINISTER FOR SPORT (MR REEVES)—

With reference to the \$60m taxpayer-funded Carrara Stadium on the Gold Coast—Will the Bligh Labor Government ensure affordable ticket prices, comparable to other Australian regional AFL stadiums, for local supporters to watch their home team play live?

ANSWER:

Neither the Queensland Government nor Stadiums Queensland set ticket prices. Ticket prices are set by the respective codes in conjunction with the clubs. With reference to Gold Coast Stadium, the Gold Coast Football Club and the Australian Football League will set the ticket prices in line with their business model.
