MRS MENKENS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITY SERVICES AND HOUSING AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (MS STRUTHERS)—

With reference to Youth Justice Service Centres—

- (1) What are the total budget and operating costs in 2008–09 for each centre across Queensland (reported by centre location)?
- (2) How many staff are employed in each centre (reported by centre and job role)?
- (3) How many young offenders are managed through each centre (reported by service centre)?

ANSWER:

The Department of Communities operates 16 Youth Justice Service Centres across Queensland. The operating budget is in excess of \$26 million annually and employs 340 (Full Time Equivalent) staff.

The total number of young people placed on supervised youth justice orders between 1 July 2008 and 30 June 2009 is 2,238.

Approximately 1,400 young people are currently under supervision.

Service centre staff include case-workers, youth workers, managers, team leaders, program coordinators and administrative staff.
