MS BATES ASKED THE MINISTER FOR MAIN ROADS (MR WALLACE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the State controlled Worongary Road—

- (1) Has there been a count of vehicles travelling on Worongary Road since 1 January 2000?
- (2) When did these counts occur and what was the breakdown of vehicles recorded for each year?
- (3) When will the next vehicle count occur on Worongary Road?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mudgeeraba for the question.

1. The state-controlled Advancetown-Mudgeeraba Road starts at the intersection of Nerang-Murwillumbah Road and ends on the northern side of the roundabout near Regency Place and consists of four locally named sections. The commonly named Worongary Road section starts at the intersection of Hinze Dam Road and ends at the intersection of Mudgeeraba Road. The Department of Transport and Main Roads began traffic counting on Worongary Road between The Panorama and Vince Hinde Drive (approximately half way along the Worongary Road section) in 2003.
2. The annual average daily traffic counts from the Hinze Dam Road intersection to Mudgeeraba intersection are as follows:

2003	4,724
2004	4,813
2005	4,228
2006	4,527
2007	4,182
2008	4,421
2009	4,818

(Heavy vehicles are identified as trucks, buses and articulated vehicles)

3. The next traffic count for this location will be scheduled towards the end of 2010.
