MR DICKSON asked the Premier and Minister for the Arts (MS BLIGH) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the Premier's election promise of 100,000 net new jobs for 100,000 breadwinners of 100,000 Queensland families –

- (1) How is the government progressing on this election promise?
- (2) Has there been one net new job created since 21 March 2009?

ANSWER:

- (1) I refer the Member to the Queensland Government's Jobs First Plan, tabled in Parliament on 01 September 2009.
- (2) In October 2009, a total of 1,900 new jobs were created, following on from the 600 jobs created in September 2009. For the second month in a row we have seen positive jobs growth in Queensland and the Government remains committed to delivering on this policy. The LNP job creation target of zero stands in stark contrast.
