Question on Notice No. 1767 Asked on Wednesday 11 November 2009

MR GIBSON asked the Minister for Infrastructure and Planning (MR HINCHLIFFE)-

QUESTION:

Given that the Coordinator-General's report has ambitious scientific and associated goals (over 1,200 in total) that must be met before full approval will be given—

Will the Queensland Government undertake not to issue compulsory property acquisition notices until these conditions are completely met?

ANSWER:

On 2 December 2009 the Federal Minister for Environment, Heritage and the Arts announced his decision not to approve the Traveston Crossing Dam Project.
