QUESTION:

Will the Minister confirm that the hydro-electric power station at Somerset Dam has been out of commission since early 2007, depriving SEQ Water of \$1m a year in revenue, and explain why the power station has taken so long to refurbish and advise when it will be operational again?

ANSWER:

Operation of the hydro-electric power station at Somerset Dam is a matter that falls within the portfolio responsibilities of the Minister for Natural Resources, Mines and Energy and Minister for Trade.
