Mrs Stuckey asked the Minister for Public Works and Information and Communication Technology (MR SCHWARTEN)-

QUESTION:

What is the total number of email licences owned by the Queensland Government, broken down by platform type (for example Microsoft Exchange, Lotus Notes/Domino, Novell GroupWise) and the average cost per licence type?

ANSWER:

Novell GroupWise email licences are included in a Corporate Licence Agreement based on a bundle of software licences for nine products which provides use of all software products to a maximum of 150,000 licences. As such, the cost of the email licence alone cannot be reported separately.

Microsoft Exchange email licences are a part of a bundled software package licensed under an Enterprise Agreement which currently provides 151,867 licences. As such, the cost of the email licence alone cannot be reported separately.

The Queensland Government owns 10,500 Lotus Notes licences at a cost of \$70 per licence (including GST).
