MR SEENEY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES, MINES AND ENERGY AND MINISTER FOR TRADE (MR ROBERTSON)—

QUESTION:

What are the terms of the contracts that exist for the supply of recycled water from Brisbane's water recycling plants and how much money has been generated each month from the sale of recycled water produced by the plants since they were commissioned?

ANSWER:

The SEQ Water Grid Manager holds contracts with local councils and power stations for the supply of purified recycled water (PRW). As the power stations are competitive commercial entities, the terms of these contracts are commercial-in-confidence.
