QUESTION:

With reference to the DPI site at Long Pocket—

- (1) What planning has been established for the disposal of the site?
- (2) What is the date set for closure of the site?
- (3) What is intended for the future of the site?

ANSWER:

Queensland Primary Industries and Fisheries, Department of Employment, Economic Development and Innovation (DEEDI) does not own any land on the site. DEEDI is moving from the site in 2011 and the Department of Environment and Resource Management, as land owner, will then be responsible for any disposal of the property.
