96 **MRS PRATT** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES (MR ROBERTS)—

With reference to the 29 state forests in the Nanango Electorate, and taking into consideration that some areas have received significant rainfall (i.e. Bellthorpe State Forest)—

- (1) What mandatory yearly fire management procedures are currently in place?
- (2) Were all these procedures undertaken in 2008?
- (3) Have additional procedures been put in place and/or undertaken in light of the recent tragedy in Victoria?
- (4) Has any extra finance been allocated to reduce fire hazards in state forests?
- (5) In the event of a fire what procedures, beyond deploying rural fire services personnel, have been put in place?
