MRS ATTWOOD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT (MS NOLAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister report on additional work completed at the Oxley railway station which further complements the recent upgrade?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mount Ommaney for the question.

The recent upgrade works at Oxley rail station, being completed by the Trackstar Alliance includes:

- one new platform and new footbridge
- new shelter
- new passenger information signage
- upgraded lighting
- additional security cameras
- 70 additional car parking spaces
- 10 additional bike lockers, and
- landscaping.

As part of Corinda to Darra project, the Ardoyne Road Footpath ramp has been re-furbished to improve accessibility and to comply with Disability Access Standards. Minor works at Oxley rail station are expected to be completed by end of September 2010.

In addition, TransLink and Queensland Rail have identified further upgrade works which will alleviate pressure on older station facilities, and improve safety and customer service for commuters waiting on platforms.

These works include:

- resurface of Platform 1 and 2
- provision of new shelters
- platform furniture
- refurbishment of heritage listed station building
- upgrade of the ticket office, station lighting, including energy efficient
- upgrade of the existing information systems
- upgrade of the subway (including the entrance amenity)
- upgrade of the bus interchange.

Construction is expected to commence on this stage of the project in late October 2010.
