MR RICKUSS asked the Minister for Public Works and Information and Communication Technology (MR SCHWARTEN) -

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise what sale price the government received for any of the 13 Chrysler diesel C300 ministerial cars that have been sold (listed by date of sale)?

ANSWER:

From January 2008, QFleet began to purchase the 300C diesel engine Chryslers following the 10 December 2007 announcement by the Premier and Minister for the Arts of a major overhaul of the government fleet. This announcement came as part of a three tiered approach to reducing carbon emissions in Queensland. From 1 January 2008, wherever operationally fit for purpose, new government cars on the fleet had to meet the minimum Green Vehicle Guide (GVG) Greenhouse Rating of 5.5 for passenger vehicles and 3.5 for light commercial vehicles. The Chrysler 300C diesel engine has a GVG rating of six.

To date QFleet has sold five Ministerial 300C diesel engine Chryslers. Please find below the date of sale and the gross sale price achieved at Auction.
