QUESTION:

With reference to the Ministers answer to Question of Notice No. 1323 regarding the closure and relocation of the Singapore Tourism Queensland office—

What is the new address and cost of maintaining all of Tourism Queensland's international offices across the world?

ANSWER:

The new address of Tourism Queensland's Singapore office is 51 Goldhill Plaza, #16-04, Singapore.

As outlined in Question on Notice No. 1323, Tourism Queensland's international offices are located in key countries to maximise trade and media opportunities. They are deliberately not set up as consumer retail shops.

The cost of maintaining all of Tourism Queensland's international offices across the world in 2010-11 is forecast to be \$2.608 million.
