Will the Minister advise how many *go* card outlets are available in the Kallangur Electorate and where these outlets are located?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Kallangur for the question.

go cards may be obtained in person at the following four locations in the Kallangur electorate:

- Kallangur Fair News 1473 Anzac Avenue, Kallangur
- Petrie rail station ticket office
- Narangba rail station ticket office
- 7-eleven Murrumba Downs 9 Blyth Road, Murrumba Downs.

Petrie rail station, Narangba rail station and Kallangur Fair News have been launched as *go* card resellers since 4 January 2010.

The TransLink Transit Authority network has over 506 retail outlets, more than any other smart card network in Australia.

go cards can also be purchased from the TransLink website (www.translink.com.au), over the phone by calling the TransLink Call Centre (13 12 30) and at selected retailers, staffed rail stations and selected busways stations.

go card users can top up their card at fare machines located at rail stations, selected busway stations and interchanges, over the phone, online, selected attended station offices, selected go card retailers and on non-Brisbane Transport Buses. go card users can also register for the auto top up functionality, this is when a customer's go card balance falls below \$5 a preset amount of their choice is transferred to their go card.
