Dr Flegg asked the Minister for Education and Training (Mr Wilson) —

QUESTION:

With reference to maintenance inspections in all schools in the Moggill Electorate—
When was the last inspection conducted at each school (reported separately) and what problems were identified (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for his question.

I have been advised by the Department that QBuild undertakes a condition assessment of each State school annually.

Maintenance inspection dates and the items identified at each school are outlined below. Brookfield State School's last condition assessment occurred on 17 August 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including scuffed carpets, lifted pavers and a blocked drain.

Chapel Hill State School's last condition assessment occurred on 21 October 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including a faulty door closer, peeling paintwork and uneven paving.

Kenmore South State School's last condition assessment occurred on 5 October 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including worn carpet, faded paintwork and uneven paving.

Kenmore State School's last condition assessment occurred on 16 October 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including marked paintwork, potholes in the carpark and uneven floor tiles.

Moggill State School's last condition assessment occurred on 23 October 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including worn carpet, uneven paving and damaged boundary fencing.

Mount Crosby State School's last condition assessment occurred on 24 March 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including uneven paving, a damaged fan speed controller and faded carpet.

Pullenvale State School's last condition assessment occurred on 13 October 2009, QBuild workers identified a number of issues including peeling paintwork, uneven paving and a broken ceiling fan.

Upper Brookfield State School's last condition assessment occurred on 15 September 2009. QBuild workers identified a number of issues including peeling paintwork, worn carpet and uneven paving.

The assessments reports, provided by QBuild, identify maintenance tasks for completion over the next 12–18 months. Any issues that present a risk to the health and safety of students or staff are dealt with immediately by QBuild.
