Mrs Sullivan asked the Minister for Education and Training (Mr Wilson)—

QUESTION: Will the Minister provide details of the work the State Government is doing in the electorate of Pumicestone with respect to school facility upgrades?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for her question and her interest in the facility upgrades of schools in her electorate.

Through the State Schools of Tomorrow Program, the State Government is investing over \$3m in facilities in the electorate of Pumicestone.

Banksia Beach State School has received a library upgrade, a covered walkway, external painting and a year 3 & 4 outdoor learning area at a cost of more than \$188,000

Beachmere State School has received a Performance Arts Enhancement Project, and a replacement shade cloth at a cost of more than \$106,000.

Bribie Island State High School has received a Community Sport and Recreation Centre, external repainting and general maintenance work at a cost of more than \$290,000.

Bribie Island State School has received a sand pit, undercover area lighting, classroom furniture and office space, external repainting and general maintenance work at a cost of more than \$211,000.

Caboolture East State School has received external repainting, general maintenance work and a Smart Space for Learning at a cost of over \$139,000.

Caboolture State High School is receiving external repainting, general maintenance, a Library Renewal and a Computer Lab refurbishment an outside learning area and a administration renovation at a cost of over \$1.7m.

Caboolture State School has received external repainting, general maintenance work and classroom and security upgrades at a cost of over \$122,000.

Tullawong State High School has received external repainting, general maintenance work and a refurbished student activity centre at a cost of over \$256,000.

Tullawong State School has received external repainting, general maintenance work and an extension to their resource centre at a cost of over \$250,000.
