MR MCLINDON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR MAIN ROADS (MR WALLACE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister outline any plans the government has for the construction of a 7km connection road between the townships of Boonah and Kooralbyn, which is a critical connect for the economic success of Kooralbyn and a second entry/exit point for safety and easier accessibility between the townships?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Beaudesert for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads has no plans for a new local connection between Boonah and Kooralbyn.

The existing state-controlled Beaudesert-Boonah Road provides east-west connectivity north of Kooralbyn.

The existing state-controlled Boonah-Rathdowney Road provides north-south connectivity east of Kooralbyn.
