Question on Notice No. 575 Asked on 24 March 2010

MR HOBBS asked the Premier and Minister for the Arts (MS BLIGH) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the Premier's recent announcements in relation to the Sustainable Resource Community Agreement –

Will the Premier advise, from 31 August 2008 to date, (a) the names of the organisations that received funding (reported separately) from this program, (b) the number of applications rejected for funding and why, and (c) what amount of funds are yet to be allocated under this program?

ANSWER:

I refer the Honourable Member to my answer to his question on notice of October 2009 (No. 1395 of 2009), which outlines the detail of individual projects announced on 22 January 2009, 18 September 2009 and during the 2009 Election Campaign. The Honourable Member should also note that since my answer was tabled on 5 November 2009, funding for the Mount Isa Hospital Redevelopment Project has been increased to \$835,000.

The detail of those individual projects that have been announced since my last answer are at Attachment 1.

The program is managed under an agreement with a Partnership Group comprising the Queensland Resources Council, Local Government Association of Queensland, relevant local councils and the State Government. An extensive list of potential projects have been identified and prioritised during detailed consultation with the Partnership Group.

A total of 35 projects have been approved and announced for funding as at 7 April 2010. Funding for these announced projects is \$98.1 million, leaving a balance of \$1.9 million yet to be allocated.

The number of jobs estimated to be created based on the current expenditure of \$98.1 million is up to 755 full time equivalent.
