Mrs Smith asked the Minister for Education and Training (Mr Wilson)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide details of the work being done on school facility upgrades in the Burleigh Electorate?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for her question and her interest in the facility upgrades of schools in her electorate.

Through the State Schools of Tomorrow Program, the State Government is investing over \$3m in facilities in the electorate of Burleigh.

Burleigh Heads State School is receiving a major General Learning Area upgrade, a relocation of a Special Education Unit and new furniture as well as extensive maintenance work at a cost of more than \$840,000.

Caningeraba State School has received a classroom upgrade and maintenance work at a cost of more than \$106,000.

Miami State High School is receiving science lab upgrades, a tuckshop upgrade and general maintenance work at a cost of more than \$1,400,000.

Miami State School has received an outdoor learning area, a major General Learning Area upgrade and general maintenance work at a cost of more than \$670,000.

Palm Beach State School has received an upgrade to their performing arts complex and general maintenance work at a cost of over \$129,000.
