MR DICKSON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR ENERGY AND WATER UTILITIES (MR ROBERTSON)——

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise if the government is considering re-locating a number of South East Queensland water entities to a single premises in the Ipswich area and if so, are the proposed premises flood prone?

ANSWER:

As part of its decentralisation key initiatives, the South East Queensland water entities were put forward for a possible move from the Brisbane Central Business District to Ipswich, which was estimated to occur by December 2013. Due to emergent priorities, the Government has decided not to progress this option involving the water entities.
