MR BLEIJIE asked the Minister for Community Services and Housing and Minister for Women (MS STRUTHERS)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister provide details of all waiting lists for social housing in the Kawana Electorate, separated by the category of need and the total time on the respective waiting lists?

ANSWER

A 'wait list' process of allocating social housing has not been used in Queensland since 2008 when the Queensland Government introduced the One Social Housing System. Under the One Social Housing System, the 'wait list' has been replaced with the Housing Register from which allocations are made on the basis of need.

As at 31 May 2011 in the electorate of Kawana, there were 1,039 social housing applications registered for long term social housing:
