**DR ROBINSON** asked the Minister for Main Roads, Fisheries and Marine Infrastructure (MR WALLACE) -

## QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Fisheries Strategy 2009-14—

Will the Minister provide a final account in relation to each of the seven key targets listed for resolution by the end of 2010?

## ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Cleveland for the question.

The seven key targets in the Fisheries Strategy 2009-14 are -

- 1. finalise the planning-based framework for marine aquaculture
- 2. finalise the future vision for the Declared Fish Habitat Area network and review of Fisheries Queensland's approach to fish habitat conservation and enhancement
- 3. complete an economic analysis of the commercial fishing industry
- 4. create a commercial fisheries development unit within Fisheries Queensland
- 5. finalise the recreational fishing development plan
- 6. finalise an Indigenous fishing strategy
- 7. revamp Fisheries Queensland's key performance indicators.

Key targets 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7 have been completed and targets 5 and 6 have been substantially progressed, with consultation of the draft plan and strategy currently occurring.
