DR DOUGLAS asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Emergency Services (MR ROBERTS)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the proceeds of crime on the Gold Coast—

- (1) Will the Minister advise the total value of assets seized on the Gold Coast in the last two years?
- (2) Will the Minister outline where the proceeds are re-invested, both in sector and location?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government operates two confiscation schemes for recovering the proceeds of crime in Queensland.

The Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions administers a conviction-based confiscation scheme and the Crime and Misconduct Commission administers a civil confiscation scheme.
